

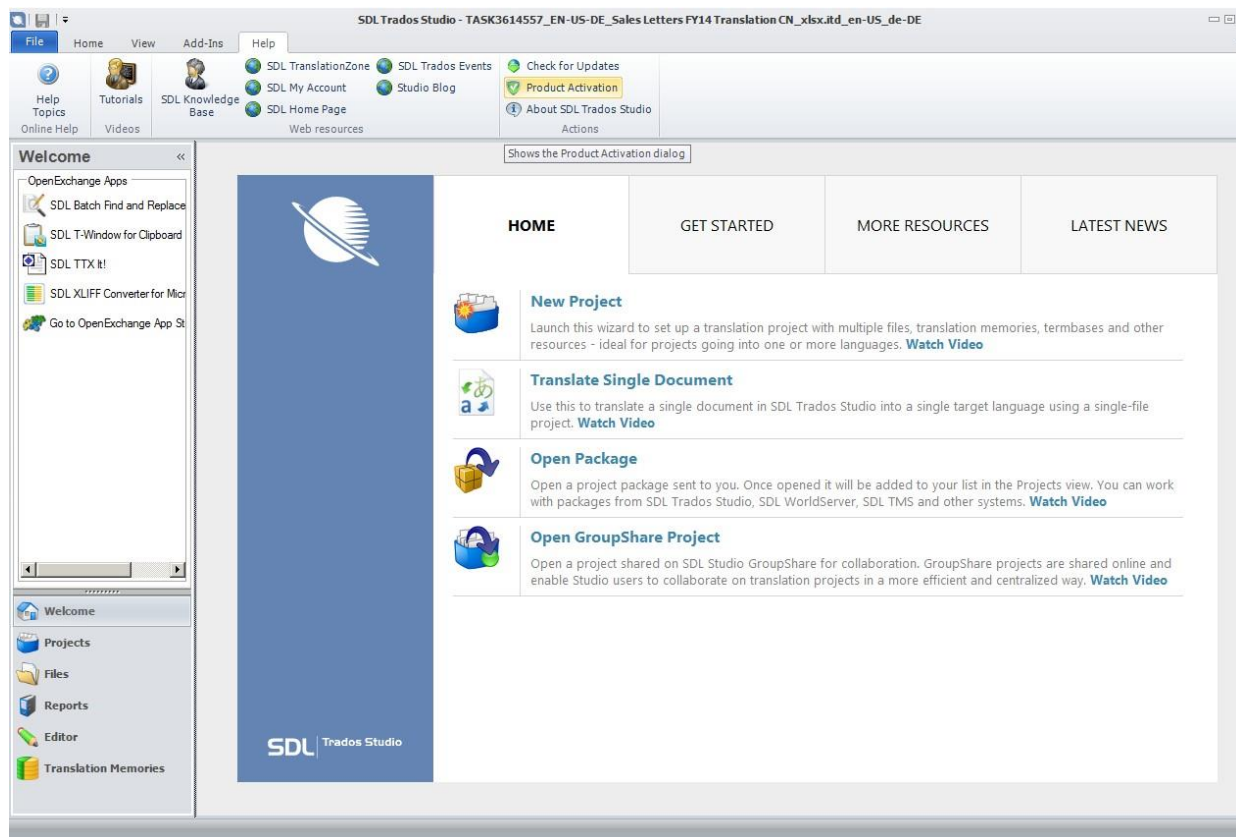
Deactivating SDL Trados Studio 2014 License

In order to renew your SDL license with expiry date of Nov 30th 2014, the first step is to “deactivate” it. Please be aware of the following:

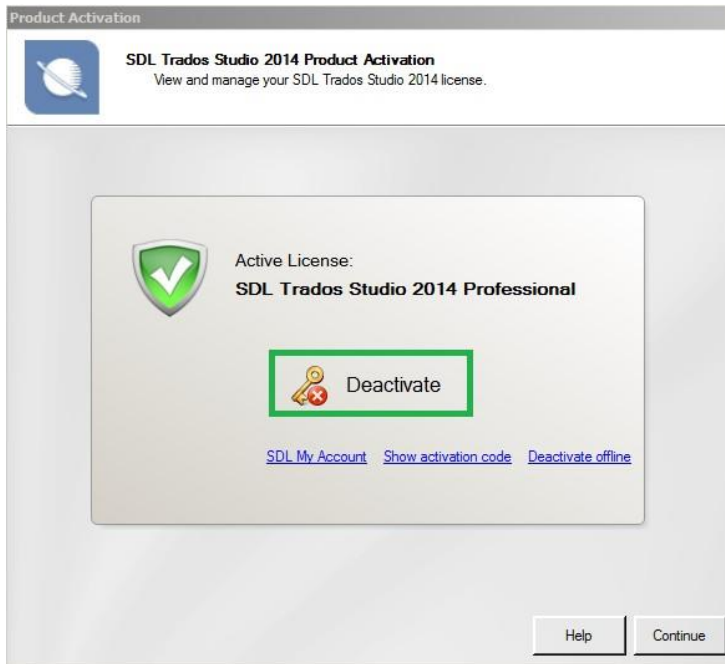
- You need to deactivate your license with expiry date of Nov 30th 2014, before activating the new license.

To deactivate your license please follow next steps:

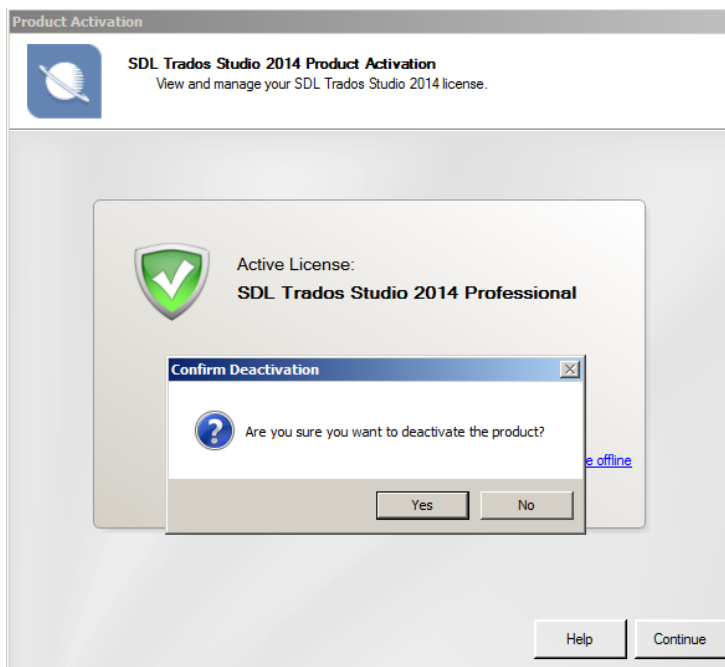
1. Open SDL Trados Studio 2014 by going to **Start > Programs > SDL > SDL Trados Studio 2014 > SDL Trados Studio 2014**. SDL Trados Studio 2014 is displayed.
2. Click **Help > Product Activation** from the menu bar. The **Product Activation** wizard is displayed.



3. Click **Deactivate** and then **Confirm** from the dialog.

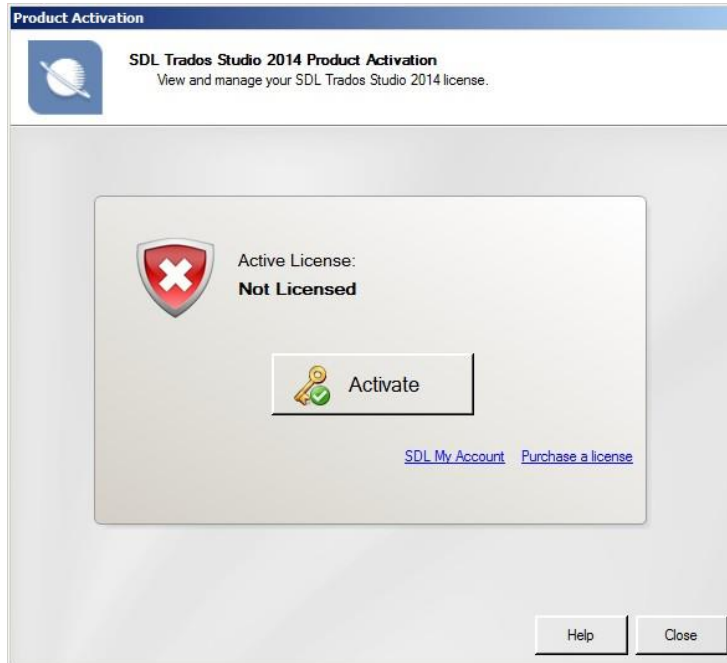


4. A confirmation message will appear to indicate that the license has been deactivated.

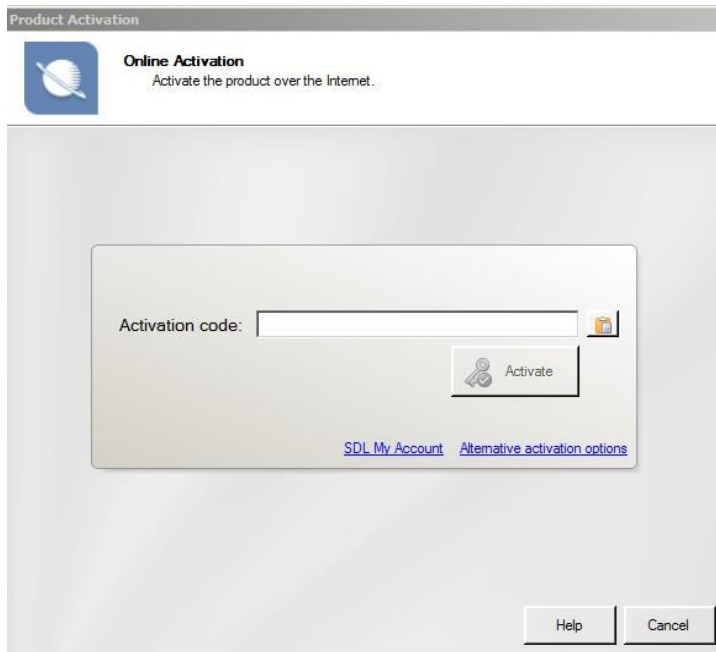


How to activate SDL Trados Studio 2014 License

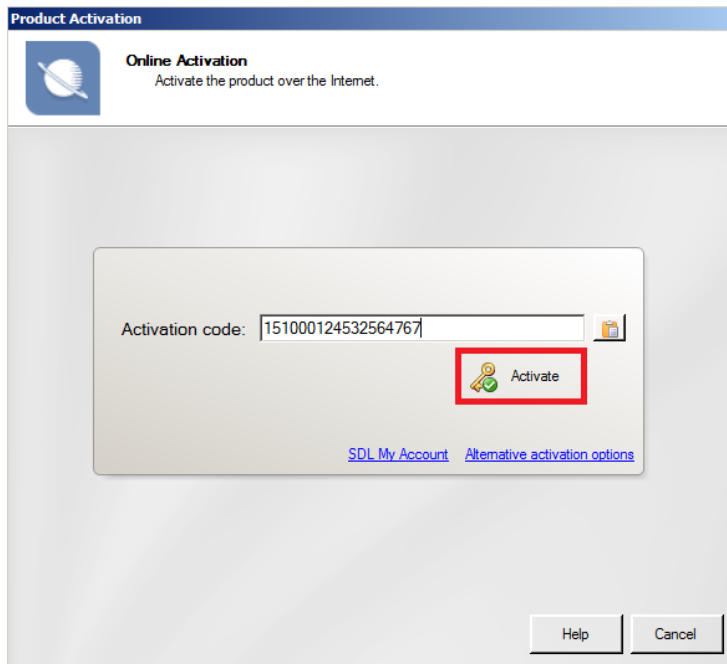
1. Open SDL Trados Studio 2014 by going to **Start > All Programs > SDL > SDL Trados Studio 2014 > SDL Trados Studio 2014**. The **Product Activation** wizard is automatically displayed.



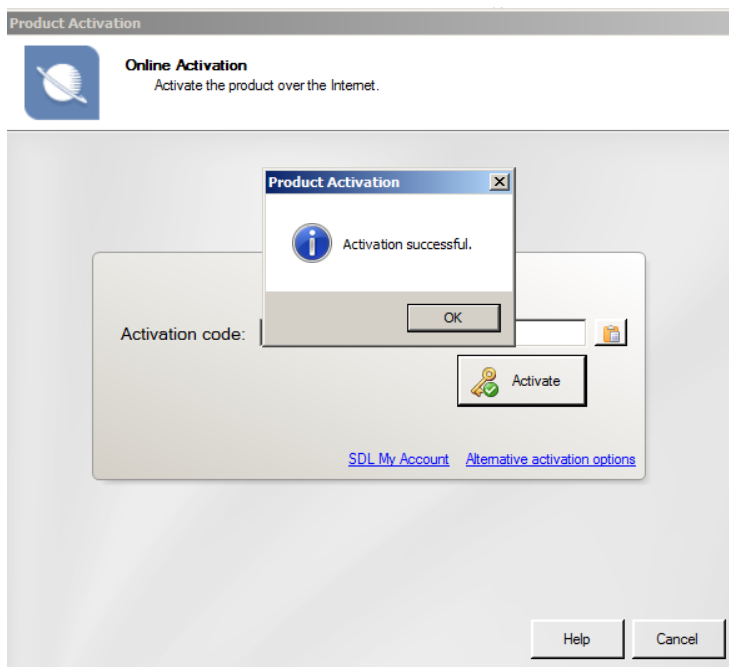
2. Click **Activate** to display the **Online Activation** page.



3. Enter or paste the activation code that you have received into the **Activation code** text field



4. Click **Activate**. The wizard connects to the Internet to validate the code. If the activation code is valid, the **Activation Successful** message is displayed.



5. Click **OK**. Your license has been successfully activated.
